



When you click *Login* you will be prompted to create a new password. Once completed you will see the Login screen again and can login using your new password.

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



which Chapter



You can use the search option at the top right of the screen to find stories with certain keywords or search for a specific name.


These icons tell you if the storyteller submitted a photo, has audio available, and if there is a written transcription.


This button allows you to view the raw unedited transcription of the audio recording.

Click on the Menu Button at the top right of the screen and the below options will appear.






