

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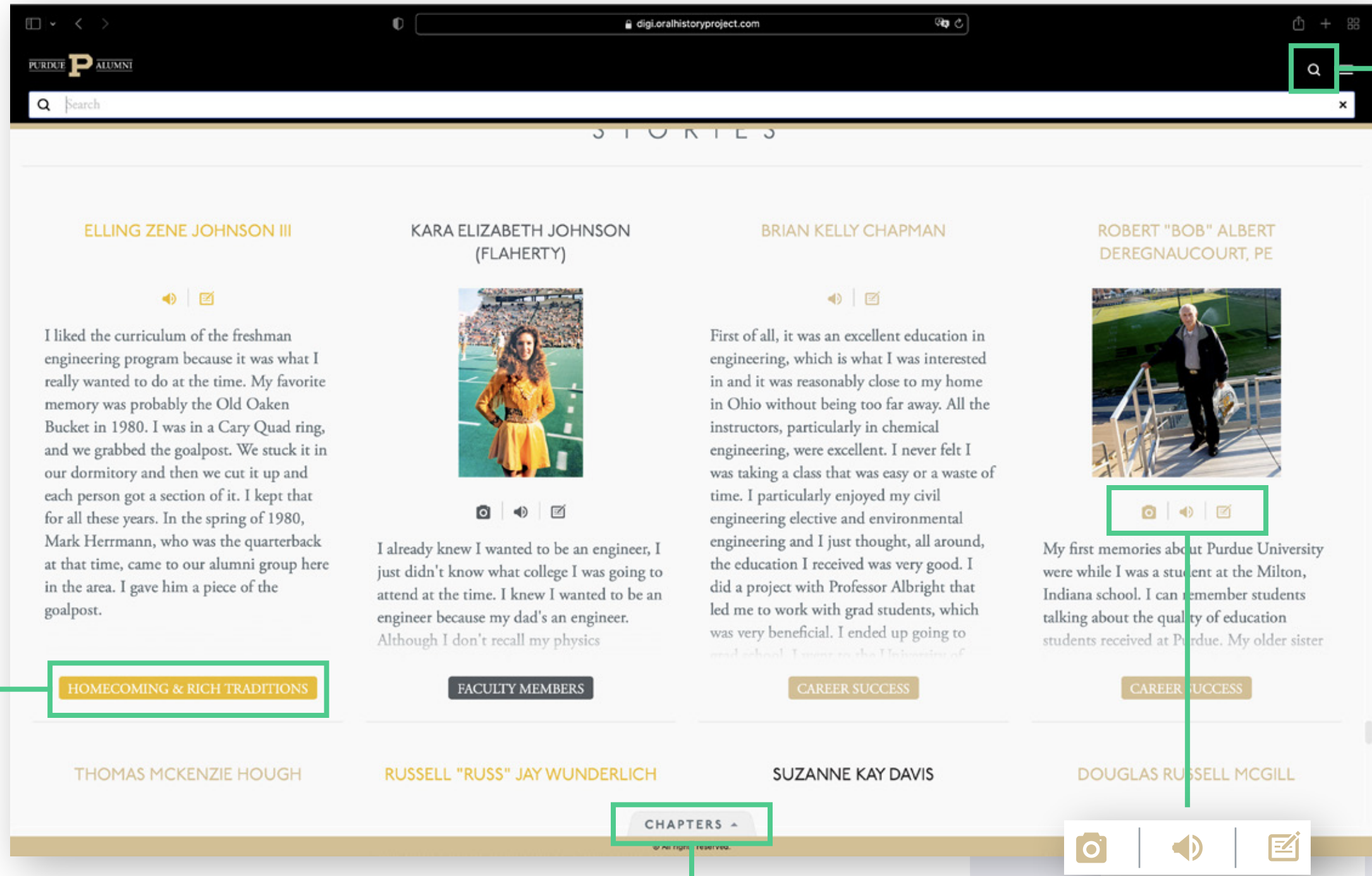
When you login for the first time you will see the Online User Agreement which must be **accepted** before you can move forward.

The main page of the Oral History Publication is a random assortment of stories from the various chapters and will change each time you visit. You can click on any story to view the entire story, listen to the audio, and/or view the photos that person submitted.



This will tell you which Chapter any given story appears under.

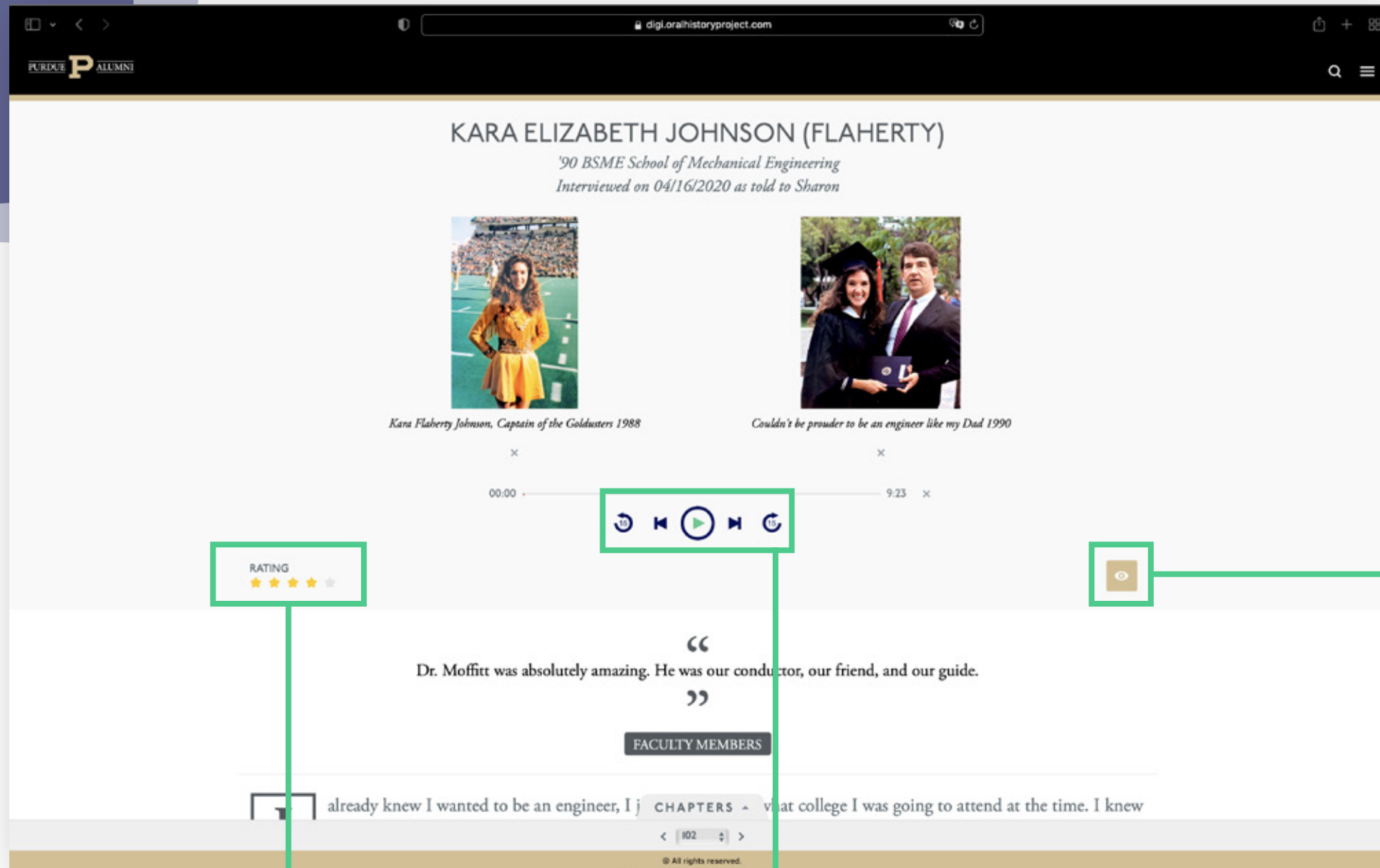
You can use the search option at the top right of the screen to find stories with certain keywords or search for a specific name.

You can select the Chapters button at the bottom of the screen to view the other Chapters available.

These icons tell you if the storyteller submitted a photo, has audio available, and if there is a written transcription.

Here are 2 examples of individual submissions.

EXAMPLE 1

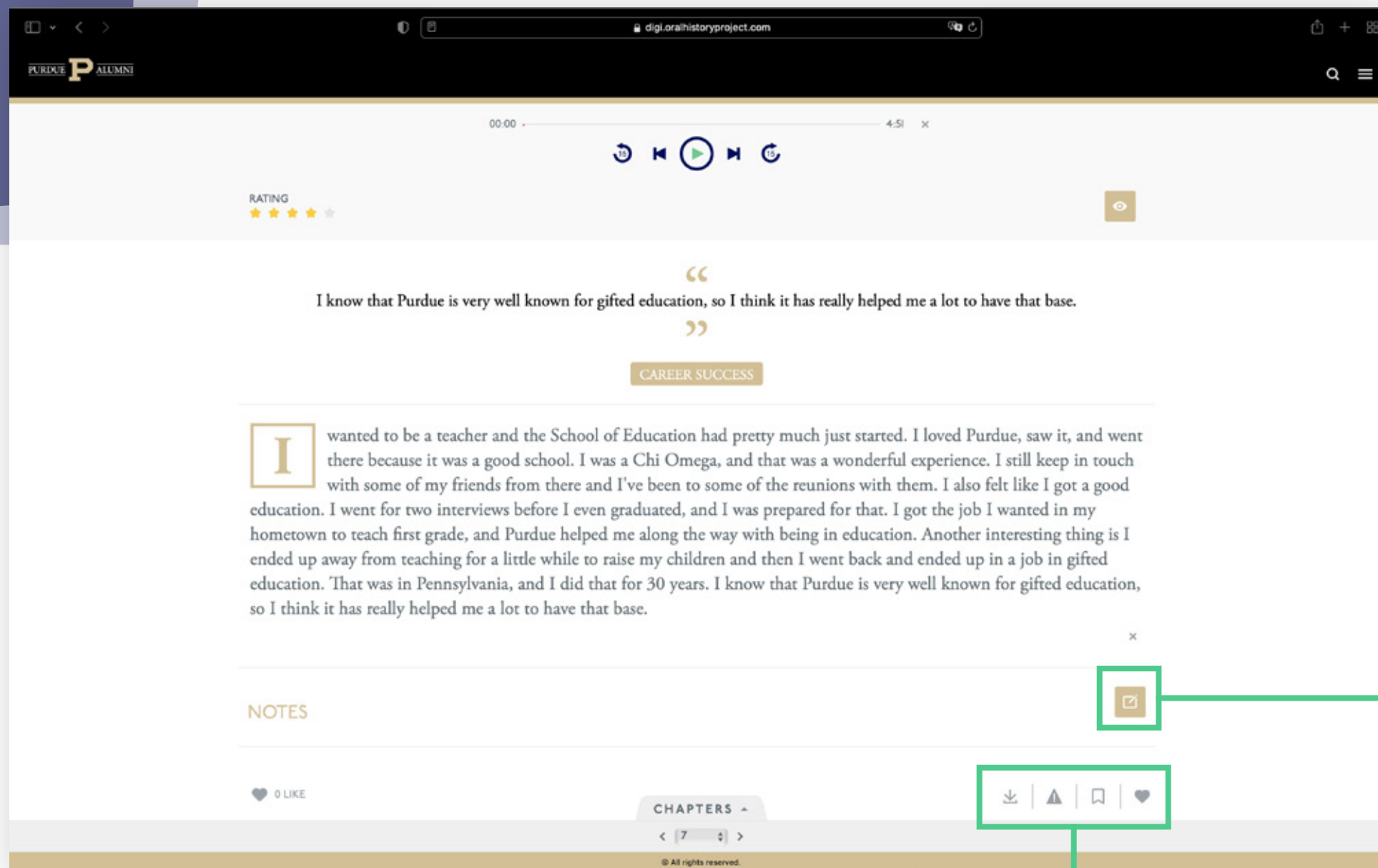


This button allows you to view the raw unedited transcription of the audio recording.

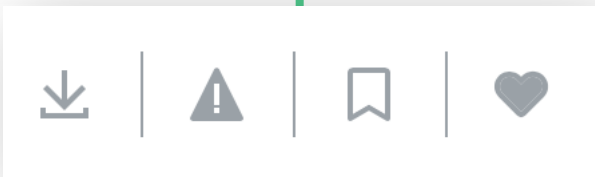
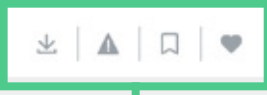
When a story is shared it is assigned a rating. This is not to signify a good versus a bad story, but instead speaks to the heartfelt nature or detail provided by the storyteller within their story. (This is only visible in the Admin version.)





These buttons allows you to play the audio of the storyteller sharing their story.

Menu Options for an Admin User:
